Local Businessman Gives Back After Emergency Brain Surgery at EvergreenHealth

Long-time EvergreenHealth patient, Kirkland resident and retired international businessman Bob Cranmer and his wife, Gail, settled in Kirkland in 1998. Part of putting down roots on the Eastside meant finding new doctors. They didn't have to look far.

The Cranmer family established care at the community hospital about four miles from their Kirkland home: EvergreenHealth. When he first established care, however, Bob had no idea he would one day become well acquainted with one of EvergreenHealth's top neurologists.

Bob and Gail were enjoying retirement between vacation travel and taking frequent trips down to Austin, Texas, to see their daughter Lisa, son-in-law Bruce, and granddaughter Jasmine. Bob was finally catching up on some leisure time after nearly six decades in the business world.

In the three years since retirement, Bob enjoyed steady health. Then last year he hit his head after a bad fall. Not thinking it was serious, he went on with his life. But as time went on, some of his cognitive symptoms indicated a bigger problem.

Bob met with doctors at EvergreenHealth's Bella Bottega Urgent Care in Redmond. After a CT scan, the physicians quickly identified brain hemorrhaging—a medical emergency that would require surgery. Bob and Gail were sent by ambulance to EvergreenHealth's primary hospital in Kirkland. EvergreenHealth neurosurgeon Dustin Hayward, MD, scrubbed in for surgery, acting quickly to seal two instances of subdural hematoma. After surgery came a long recovery.


"I was out of it for a while," Bob said. For about eight months, he was closely monitored by Patrick Duffy, PA-C, a neurosurgical physician assistant, as the blood from his brain was reabsorbed into his body.

Today, Bob is healthy—something he attributes to the exceptional care at EvergreenHealth.

"That was such a big and scary experience," Bob said of his brain surgery. "It kind of stimulated me to give to EvergreenHealth." He understands how critical it is to have exceptional health care in his backyard, and why it matters to support investments in life-saving technology and clinical excellence.




"We are very fortunate to have landed where we landed," Bob said, "and found a place like EvergreenHealth to be our primary care facility long-term."


